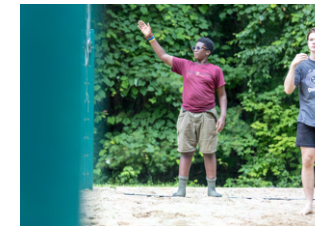


# SPECIALTY PROGRAMS
